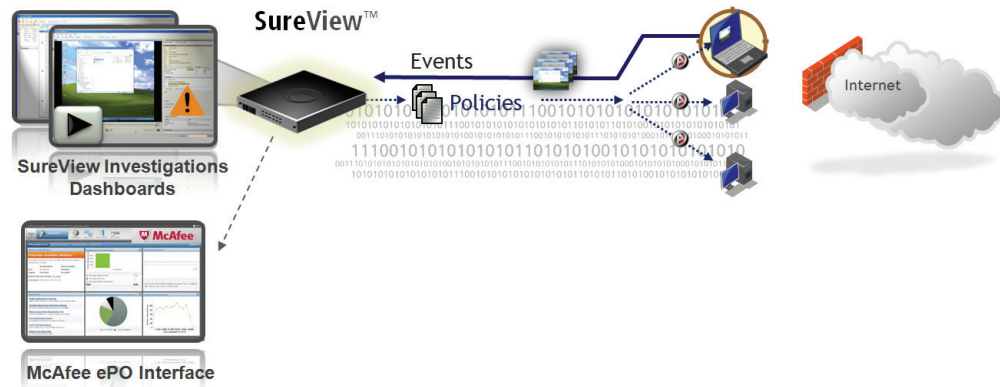


Figure 1. Raytheon SureView and McAfee ePO software integration.
