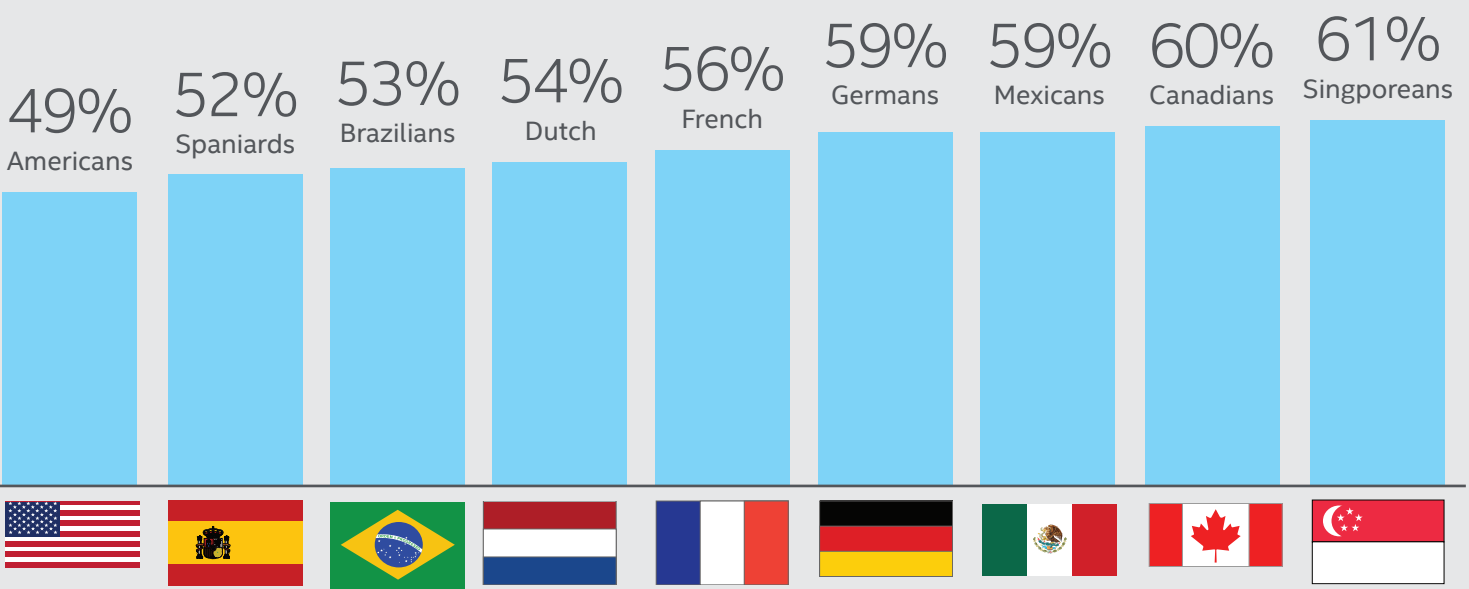

Tips for connecting to work safely



Make sure **up-to-date security software** is installed and active on all devices before you leave.



Use **PINS, passwords, and bio-metric security** to lock and secure devices.

VPN

Use **encryption and a virtual private network (VPN)** to connect to company resources.



Avoid free or public Wi-Fi. Use only encrypted and password-protected Wi-Fi and turn off automatic connections to devices.



Turn off Bluetooth when you don't need it to avoid unwanted connections from other devices.
