- List the installation processes, and identify the error messages and codes.
- List the installation processes, identify the different options under firewall extension and in the client user interface.
- Identify the different system scans, and list the on-access and on-demand scan settings.
- Identify the different settings, specify the set of actions, learn how to set the default search engine, and define actions to take for rated sites.
