## How to Apply V-Flashes

Hercules customers can use the Hercules Administrator to manage review/manage their V-Flash updates. V-Flash update can be performed on demand or on a scheduled basis. To perform a V-Flash on demand, go to the Operations Center and click on the V-Flash tab. Then click on V-Flash Now. The progress will be indicated on the screen (refresh may be required). Settings can be modified by clicking the V-Flash Settings button and modifying for the desired day interval and time and clicking OK. For full details on V-Flash, consult the "Manage V-Flash Server Operations" section of the Hercules User's Guide.
